

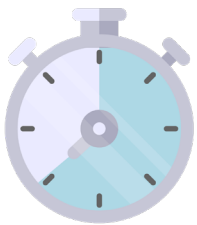

 **Update** your devices and applications with the latest security updates.




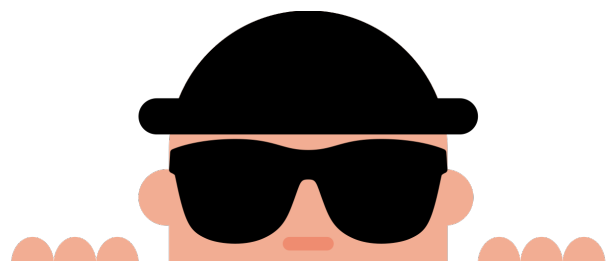
94% of malicious software is delivered by email.
